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**Summary of research assignment or task**

Students were to write a research paper on a current topic related to their major. Professor also wanted their research paper to include a variety of source types, including scholarly journals and newspaper articles.

Students will understand the difference between scholarly journals, trade and popular press publications, newspaper reports, and opinion pieces.

Students will be able to use Academic Search Elite and ProQuest Central to find particular source types on the topic of their choosing.

In their papers, students will use appropriate source types to convey information and as evidence in their arguments.
